Introduction

Numbers have fascinated mathematicians for millennia, holding secrets that unlock a world of relationships and patterns. This project delves into three fundamental concepts that have been instrumental in unraveling these mysteries: Greatest Common Divisor (GCD), Diophantine Equations, and their solutions.

Our journey begins with the concept of GCD, a cornerstone of number theory. Its origins can be traced back to ancient civilizations like the Babylonians and Greeks, who intuitively grasped the importance of finding the largest number that divides two integers evenly. The Euclidean Algorithm, developed by the brilliant Greek mathematician Euclid around 300 BC, provides a systematic and efficient method to calculate the GCD. This elegant algorithm, still used today, lays the foundation for our further exploration.

Next, we encounter Diophantine Equations, named after the 3rd-century Greek mathematician Diophantus. These equations challenge us to find integer solutions (x, y, and potentially z) that satisfy a specific linear relationship. For instance, the equation ax + by = c asks for integer values of x and y that, when multiplied by coefficients a and b and added together, result in the integer c. The resolution of these equations not only requires an understanding of GCD but also reveals fascinating connections between divisibility and integer solutions.

Finally, we extend our investigation to three-variable Diophantine Equations of the form ax + by + cz = k and furthermore the case of n variables. Building upon the knowledge gained from two-variable equations and GCD, we explore the existence and methods for finding solutions in this more complex setting.

New Definition of MSMEs

At present, the Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act 2006 (Section 7) classifies the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) on the basis of investment in plant and machinery for manufacturing units, and investment in equipment for service enterprises. In February 2018, the Union Cabinet had approved changes in the basis of classifying Micro, Small and Medium enterprises from 'investment in plant & machinery/equipment' to 'annual turnover'. The objective of the change is to encourage ease of doing business, collection make the norms of classification growth oriented.

Contribution of MSMEs in Indian Economy

As per the 73rd round of National Sample Survey (NSS) 2015-16, there were 633.88 lakh unincorporated non-agriculture MSMEs in the country engaged in different economic activities (196.65 lakh in Manufacturing, 0.03 lakh in Non-captive Electricity Generation and Transmission, 230.35 lakh in Trade and 206.85 lakh in other Services) excluding the MSMEs registered under (a) Sections 2m(i) and 2m(ii) of 2 the Factories Act, 1984, (b) Companies Act, 1956 and (c) Construction activities falling under F Section of National Industrial Classification (NIC) 2008 and provides employment to over 1109.89 lakh persons. The contribution of MSME sector India's Gross Value Added (GVA) and Gross Domestic Product are 31.83 per cent and 28.90 per cent respectively during 2016-17. The MSME sector has the potential to spread industrial growth across the country and can be a major partner in the process of inclusive growth.






National webinar on SocialJustice-2024:






